The JDRF Capitol Chapter and members of the commercial real estate industry have joined together to prove what we strongly believe - that there is a cure for diabetes. JDRF, the leading charitable funder and advocate of juvenile (type 1) diabetes research worldwide, was founded in 1970 by the parents of children with juvenile diabetes – a disease which strikes children suddenly, makes them insulin-dependent for life, and carries the constant threat of devastating complications. In a typical year, more than 80 percent of JDRF's expenditures directly support research and research-related education. JDRF's mission is constant: to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research.

## HISTORY OF THE GAMES

Adam Singer and Rick Kimbell founded the Real Estate Games in 1989. Since the establishment of the Games, each year has shown increases in event sponsorships, team participation and contributions. In 2007 the Games raised \$425,000 for diabetes research and our 2008 goal is to raise \$450,000.
